A fresh, delightfully dry alternative to hanepoot (a traditional sweet wine), with that evocative floral fruit on the nose, followed by soft apple and pear on the palate. Beautiful on a hot summer day.

Saignee 210

A dry, substantial rosé, slightly oaked, with an unapologetic acidity. Great food wine.

Fernskloof Tinta Barocca 230

Traditional port grapes, crafted into a wonderful dry red, whilst capturing the essence of the Karoo heat and sun.

Elegant Pinot Noir from a cool pocket in the Outeniqua mountains, aged for 14 months, is totally oblivious of the fact that the same quantity of cinsault, humble old-timer workhorse, is undergoing the same treatment. The day arrives and they are introduced to each other in the bottle. Like pinotage, but not pinotage. That's the paradox.

Older vines sourced from all over the Klein Karoo, delivering a pure, fresh chenin, a taste of soft stone fruit, golden kiwi and pear aromas.

This wine is a prime example of how, when you know the rules, you can break them. Two seasoned winemakers unleashed their spirit for adventure and created this fragrant blend of Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc, Viognier, Verdelho and sometimes Hárslevelű. It's bold, aromatic and complex – elegant rebellion in liquid form.

Old-world-style Shiraz with just a dash of Viognier gives you that leathery, spicy, perfumed nose with quite a bit of vanilla and then you are rewarded by a full, rich palate and a long, lingering aftertaste. And what is the fifth element? Passion!

CSV 210

An easy, crisp and aromatic wine, happily gate-crashing your meal. Extrovert Chenin Blanc, teaming up with zesty troublemaker Sauvignon Blanc and flirty Viognier are guaranteed to make the occasion memorable.

Mintberry Merlot 210

Berry party! No need for a tuxedo and philosophical chit-chat. Just a fresh breeze of minty eucalyptus, a cozy hug of light oak and the stage is set for whatever the kitchen sends your way!

One Tree Hill Pinotage 260

Rolling up like a sun-drenched Karoo legend. Juicy, ripe raspberry and black cherry, rich dark chocolate, whispers of sweet tobacco and vanilla. All hidden in the dark ruby robes swirling in your glass.

Wonderfully crafted wine by one of South Africa's wine legends. Grapes from the Swartland, a hint of apricots and lemon.

Peter Bayly III 380

A real novelty – three important port wine varieties blended as a table wine. These grapes grow high up against the Swartberg mountains, working hard to get water amongst the shoal. The result is a plush, broody wine, perfect with lamb shank and other intense flavours.

A portion of the base wine is fermented in French oak barrels while a further 15% of reserve wine from the 8 previous vintages is also blended in. These techniques contribute to the complexity and elegance – as do the extended 7 years maturation on lees plus an extra year of maturation on the cork. We are so proud to stock this fait accompli.

A word from our Coffee Roaster

Karoo Roast

Karoo Roast is the name of my little coffee roastery in Prince Albert. The beans grew in the Brazilian and El Salvador sun and are roasted with an electrical roaster, powered by the same sun. For Yellow House I make a blend of Brazil Cerrado and the El Salvador Santa Ana.

Cerrado coffee is generally clean with a good body (creamy mouthfeel), low acidity, well-balanced, and often exhibiting a nutty and even slightly caramelly flavour and more chocolaty with a the little darker roast

The Santa Ana has a round body with honey, melon, Grapefruit taste with a hint of spice. It's bright with sweet acidity.

Why I like it. It's rich, sweet and balanced. Gentle with wine tones, fruit and low-key floral notes run through an aroma and cup, rounding toward milk chocolate in the finish.

Enjoy a nice cup of coffee at Yellow House.
